CASES TRIED OR OTHERWISE TAKEN TO JUDGMENT

Network-1 v. Hewlett Packard Enterprise (E.D. Tex. 2017)

Counsel for HPE in a week-long patent jury trial involving Power over Ethernet technology. The case resulted in a defense verdict, in which all asserted claims of the patent were found not to be infringed, and were also found to be invalid. Following post-trial motions, the district court upheld the non-infringement verdict but vacated the verdict of invalidity. On appeal, the Federal Circuit affirmed in part, reversed in part and remanded the case for further proceedings.

Endo Pharmaceutical Solutions Inc. v. Paddock Laboratories LLC (D. Del. 2016)

Trial counsel for Bayer and its exclusive licensee Endo in ANDA litigation relating to Endo's Avedo® testosterone undecanoate injection. Complete trial and appellate victory for Endo and Bayer.
