

BARTLIT BECK WINS TESTOSTERONE INJECTION PATENT APPEAL FOR ENDO AND BAYER



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Scott McBride, Nevin Gewertz, Faye Paul Teller, and Meg Fasulo won a complete affirmance of a trial victory for Bayer and Endo Pharmaceuticals in ANDA litigation over Endo's testosterone undecanoate intramuscular injection Avedo®. Avedo® is the first FDA-approved long-acting testosterone replacement therapy injectable. Defendant Custopharm, Inc. sought to market a generic version of Avedo® and challenged as obvious two patents covering Avedo®'s unique composition and dosing regimen. At a bench trial in 2016, Judge Sue Robinson of the District of Delaware issued a memorandum opinion and order finding that Custopharm, Inc. had failed to show that the patents covering Avedo® were invalid as obvious.
